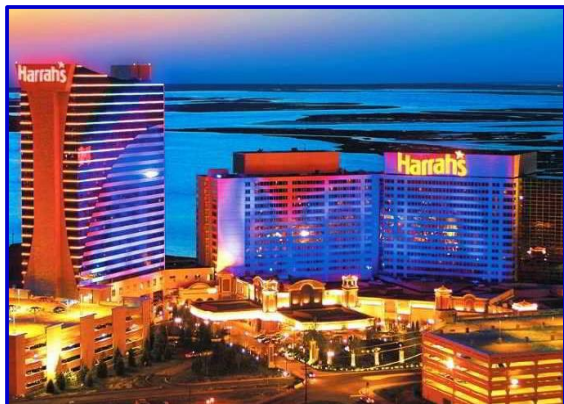

- Rail service to and from Atlantic City is provided by New Jersey (NJ) Transit, which arrives at the rail terminal adjacent to the Atlantic City Convention Center.
- NJ Transit rail service to Atlantic City is conveniently accessible daily via Amtrak through Philadelphia's 30th Street Station.
- NJ Transit also offers bus service to its terminal located at Atlantic and Ohio Avenues from New York City, Philadelphia and other major cities.

- Amtrak offers a **10%** discount off the best available rail fare to Philadelphia, PA between October 7, 2017 – October 19, 2017. To book your reservation call Amtrak 1-(800) 872-7245 or contact your local travel agent.
- Conventions cannot be booked via Internet. Please be sure to refer to Convention Fare Code **X34E-967** when making your reservation. This offer is not valid on the Auto Train and Acela Service. Fare is valid on Amtrak Regional for all departures seven days a week, except for holiday blackouts. Offer valid with Sleepers, Business Class or First Class seats with payment of the full applicable accommodation charges.



Note: There is no Amtrak rail service to Atlantic City from Delaware, Maryland, New York, Pennsylvania and Tri State; therefore, guests traveling on Amtrak will purchase a ticket going to Atlantic City, NJ and will exit the Amtrak train at 30th Street Station in Philadelphia, PA and then proceed to the track to board the New Jersey Transit to travel to Atlantic City, New Jersey.

Free Rail Terminal Shuttle Service To Harrah's Resort

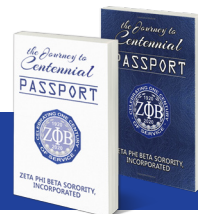

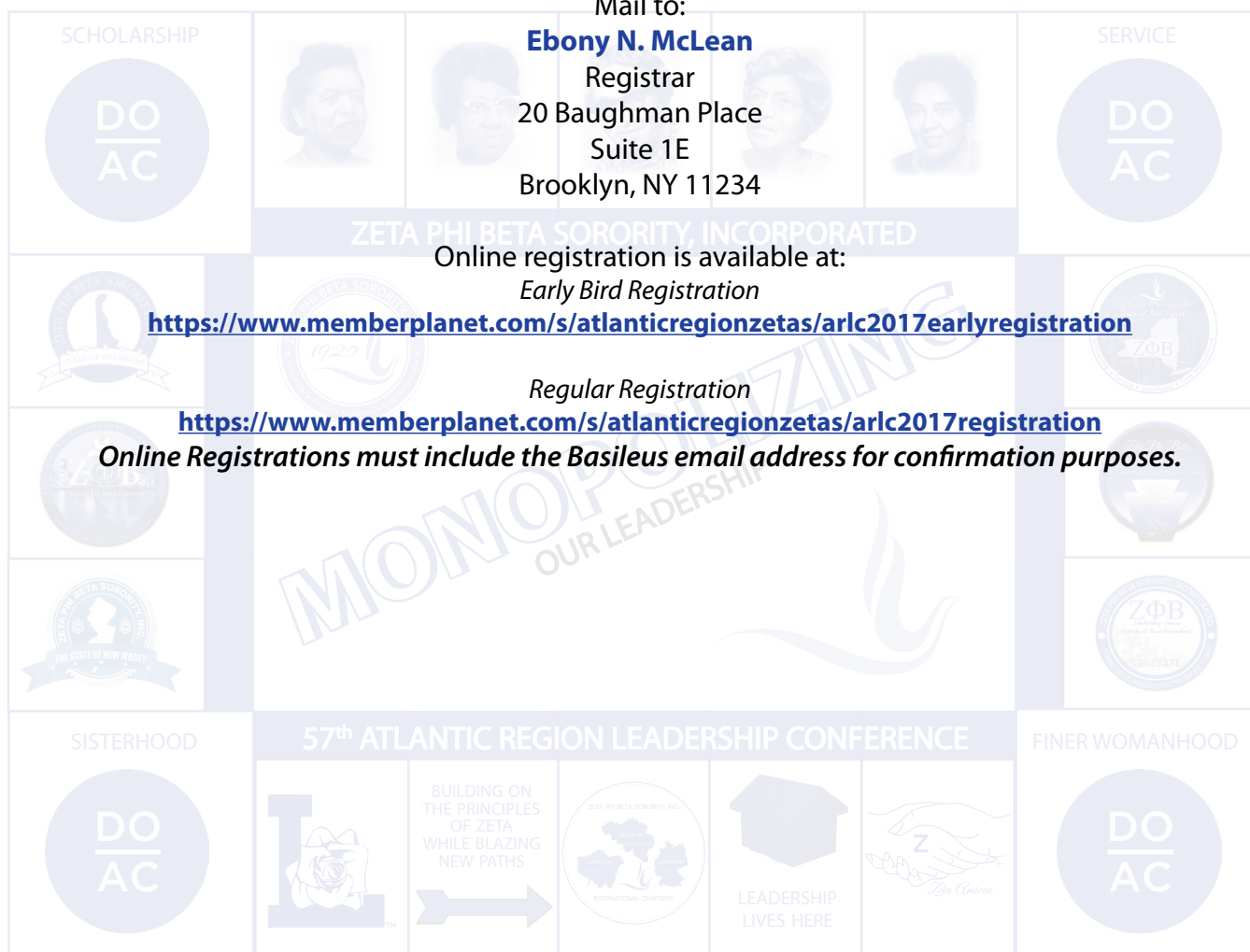

In 2002, his museum became a reality when he was offered a space by the mayor of Buena Vista Township. In 2013, the museum became the anchor for Noyes Arts Garage - a Stockton University facility.

The only African American Heritage Museum in NJ documenting the African American experience of the 20th Century. More than 11,000 treasures showcased on a rotating basis, updated every 30 days. Open Tuesday-Friday, 10am - 4pm, Saturday by appointment. The museum also provides a collection of Atlantic County soldiers' memorabilia from World War I to present at the All Wars Memorial Building in Atlantic City.
